

What is Apporto Virtual Classroom and how do faculty use it?

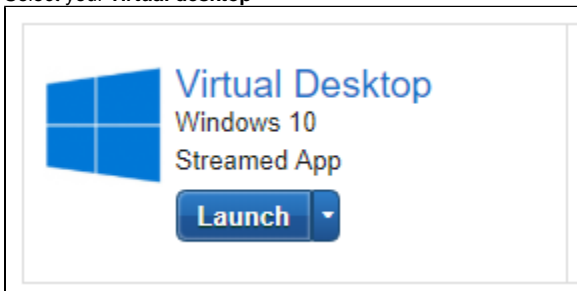
Note

The Virtual Classroom enables faculty to monitor and assist students. It provides a real-time view of the desktops of all students in a particular group who are online – all from a single screen. Students can raise their hands to ask questions. Faculty can click to get a closer view of a student's desktop and request remote control to help a student along.

An Apporto Group must be created which includes your current student roster. Please use [this FAQ](#) to request a Group for your class.

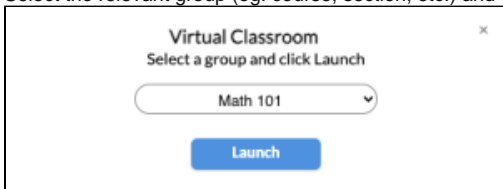
1. Go to apporto.charlotte.edu
2. Click **Login**
3. Enter your NinerNet username and password
4. Select your **virtual desktop**




5. Click **Virtual Classroom**



6. Select the relevant group (eg. course, section, etc.) and click **Launch**.



7. The Virtual Classroom will open in a new browser tab.
