

What is Apporto?

Tell Me

1. Apporto provides faculty and students access to VIRTUAL applications stored in the Cloud.
 - a. Since the applications are stored in the cloud, it is not on your local computer and can be accessed anytime from any device.
 - b. Apporto provides a consistent experience no matter what hardware you are using.
 - c. Apporto is helpful for doing homework and not having to come on-campus to use a lab or install the applications on your computer.
2. Specialized software is available in Apporto e.g. SAS, RStudio, etc.
3. To get started:
 - a. Faculty should contact the IT Service Desk, 704-687-5500, to request Apporto for a course
 - b. Students must be enrolled in one of these courses; your faculty member will let you know if this is the case.
